Her background includes teaching positions for students with dyslexia and related learning disabilities, and students in general and special education. Denise has a master's degree in elementary education with an emphasis in reading from Mount Mercy University. She is a director for the Slingerland Institute for Literacy and is currently president of the Iowa Branch of the International Dyslexia Association.
